Overview

What type of power outlet does Brazil use?

Now you know! Brazil uses Type N power outlets - which fit both Type N and Type C power plugs. Voltage varies by location, and may be 127 or 220 volts. If your devices aren't compatible with Brazil's plug type or voltage, you'll need to bring a Brazil power outlet adaptor and possibly a voltage converter.

What power supply does Brazil use?

Brazil operates on a 127/220V supply voltage and 60Hz. The power supply in Brazil is 127V, however some of the newer hotels operate at 220V. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V. It can be extremely dangerous to use an electrical appliance that is rated at a voltage different from the supply.

What type of plug does Brazil use?

For Brazil there are two associated plug types, types C and N. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins. Plug type N is the plug which has two round pins and a grounding pin. Brazil operates on a 127/220V supply voltage and 60Hz. The power supply in Brazil is 127V, however some of the newer hotels operate at 220V.

Do I need a Brazil power adaptor?

If your devices don't have a compatible plug with the Brazil power plug type (Type N), you will definitely need a Brazil power adaptor. You can either buy a Type C or Type N adaptor for Brazil, or, consider buying a universal travel adaptor.

Brazil Travel Adaptors
Voltage Converters and Transformers
Dual Voltage Rated Appliance
Single Voltage Rated Appliances
You can determine whether you'll need to use a converter or transformer, by looking at the appliance rating plate. A dual voltage rated appliance will display for example 'INPUT: 110-240V' on the body of the appliance or its power supply. This means that you will not need a converter or transformer but just a travel adaptor, because Brazil operates

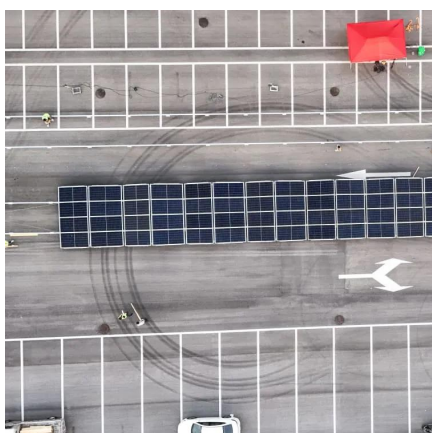
